Kirsten Murfitt's Petition to Exit The WHO Gains Momentum

DID YOU KNOW:

- 88% of WHO funding now comes from private donors.
- 10% of WHO funds come from a single donor.
- The Pandemic Treaty may override NZ's health decisions.
- WHO Foundation was created without member consultation.
- NZ spent \$31 million on Swine Flu vaccines for just 69 deaths.
- Estimated global cost to implement new IHRs: \$124 billion over 5 years.
- NZ allocated \$58.4 billion to COVID-19 response via the CRRF.
- WHO controls only 25% of its own budget.
- US exited the WHO in 2020 and again in 2025.
- 400,000 wet ink signatures needed to trigger a referendum.





The energy was electric on Sunday, March 16, as a passionate crowd gathered to hear Kirsten Murfitt speak at a packed event hosted by Rock The Vote NZ. Her presentation on the Citizen-Initiated Referendum Petition to Exit the World Health Organization (WHO) was not only informative—it was a rallying cry for action. Following her talk, Rock The Vote NZ Chairperson, Michael Avenell, sat down with Kirsten for an eye-opening interview that's now available for viewing on our YouTube channel here:

Kirsten laid out the facts, the risks, and the urgency of reclaiming New Zealand's sovereignty when it comes to global health policy. The WHO, she argues, is set to gain unprecedented influence over member countries in the event of a declared health emergency, bypassing democratic checks and balances. This, she believes, is not just concerning—it's unacceptable.

Now more than ever, the petition to Exit the WHO needs every New Zealander's support. With a target of 400,000 signatures, this citizen-initiated referendum has the power to force a national conversation—and a public vote—on whether New Zealand should continue to be a member of the WHO.

Speak Up in the COVID-19 Royal Commission Inquiry

In one of the most significant inquiries of our time, the New Zealand Royal Commission of Inquiry into COVID-19 has entered Phase 2—and your voice is needed more than ever.

This phase is tasked with assessing key decisions made by the government during the pandemic, including:

- The use of vaccines, mandates, and their approvals
- The impact and legitimacy of lockdowns, particularly in late 2021
- The reliability and fairness of testing and tracing technologies, including RATs and the COVID-19 Tracer app
- The role and effectiveness of public health materials, like mask guidelines

We know the pandemic impacted people differently. Some suffered job losses. Others faced medical discrimination. Some families were torn apart by border closures and mandates. Whatever your experience, now is the time to share your story.

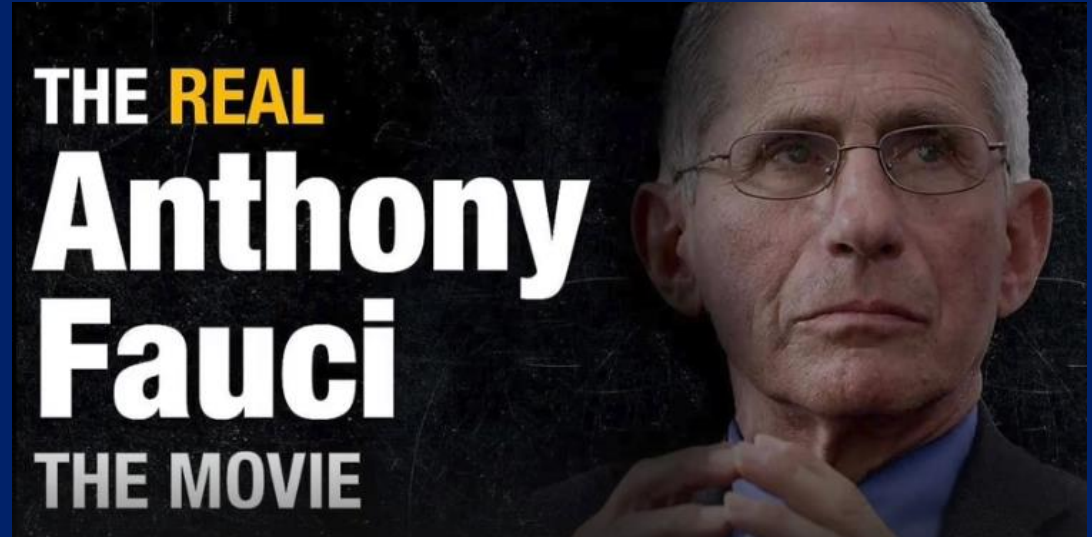


FACTS ABOUT ANTHONY FAUCI:

- Born: December 24, 1940, in Brooklyn, New York.
- Profession: American physician and immunologist.
- NIH Role: Served as Director of the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases (NIAID) from 1984 to 2022.
- COVID-19: Became a leading public health figure during the COVID-19 pandemic in the U.S.
- HIV/AIDS Work: Played a critical role in early HIV/AIDS research and response.
- Presidential Advisor: Advised seven U.S. presidents on health issues, from Ronald Reagan to Joe Biden.
- Education: Earned his M.D. from Cornell University Medical College in 1966.
- Awards: Received the Presidential Medal of Freedom in 2008.
- Retirement: Retired from government service in December 2022 after nearly 40 years at NIAID.

5G CONCERNS:

- Higher radiation levels may result from dense 5G antenna networks.
- Small cell towers are placed close to living spaces.
- Electromagnetic exposure causes symptoms in sensitive individuals, science remains inconclusive.
- Long-term health effects of 5G remain largely untested and unknown.

Wi-Fi 6 CONCERNS:

- Wi-Fi 6 increases connected devices and total EMF exposure indoors.
- Routers emit radiation constantly, even when not in use.
- Some studies suggest EMF exposure may affect human sleep patterns.

SHARED CONCERNS:

- More connected devices increase risk of cybersecurity and hacking threats.
- Tech rollout may widen digital divide and deepen social inequality.

Well-known and respected freedom fighter, horticulturalist, politician, philosopher, and community and social services professional, Brad Flutey will be talking about his recent experience in prison enduring a 73-day hunger strike. Arrested and imprisoned for refusing to wear a mask in a shop during the 'pandemic', Brad will be covering the constant attempts in prison to get him to sign documents under duress, harassment and soft torture tactics from guards, and "a totally incompetent medical administration" that refused to treat him when things got dire.

After being admitted to hospital with dehydration and vomiting blood 57 days into his hunger strike, Brad came close to losing the battle to stand up for our human rights, but fortunately, after being returned to prison after his hospital stay to continue serving his sentence, Brad made it through and he continues to speak out against tyranny and injustice. You will hear a near complete story of Brad's journey, from the incident that started it all, to its strange, abrupt conclusion.
